Groomer Maintenance Committee

This committee will be on a call list for when the groomer needs maintenance or repairs. Kirk, Ken and/or Dave can oversee this one. (4-6 people)

Claytonfest Setup Committee

This committee will be in charge of attending the Clayton Town meetings and the set up of tents, bar, grill, tubs, ice, food, and beverages. (5-10 people)
